## Who should attend these courses?

Operators holding a permanent approval for transport of dangerous goods.

IATA Cat. 10 – Flight Crew, Loadmasters, Load planners,

Flight Operations Officers, Flight Dispatchers

IATA Cat. 11 – Crew members (other than Flight Crew)

IATA Cat. 12 – Security Staff

Operators NOT holding a permanent approval for transport of dangerous goods

IATA Cat. 13 – Cargo acceptance staff (not DG)

IATA Cat. 14 – Handling Staff

IATA Cat. 15 – Passenger Handling Staff

IATA Cat. 16 – Flight crew, load planners and Flight operation officer

IATA Cat. 17 – Crew members (other than flight crew)

## Prerequisites

None.

The courses complies with both initial and recurrent training requirements.

## Training Objective

Personnel must be trained in the requirements commensurate with their responsibilities.

- General familiarization training – familiarity with the general provisions.
- Function specific training – detailed training relevant for the job function.
- Safety training – identifying hazards, handling and emergency procedures.

## Course Content

The courses covers the following requirements from IATA Table H.A.1.5.A and H.A:1.5.B

- General philosophy
- Limitations incl. Lithium batteries
- List of Dangerous Goods
- Labelling and markings
- Recognition of undeclared dangerous goods
- Storage and loading procedures\*
- Pilots' notification\*
- Provision for passengers and crew
- Emergency procedures

Applicable to the IATA Category.
