



Part 145 Regulation Training

Preamble

Regulations and standards form the basis for all we do in aviation.

EASA specifies the legal minimum in the Basic Regulation, the implementing parts and the associated AMC/GM.

Having a good knowledge about the content and implications of these regulations will enable staff to navigate them efficiently and ensure implementation of them in a cost-effective manner.

Compliance

EASA 145.A.30 states that Nominated Persons shall demonstrate a working knowledge of the Part 145 regulations.

Who should attend?

This training is intended for personnel working, or going to be working, within a Part 145 environment – especially as a Nominated Person or as a designated deputy.

Accountable Managers as well as quality staff/auditors will benefit from this training as well.
