The course explains the EASA amendment process including NPA and CRT. This is done through an interactive learning approach in which discussions of implementation and compliance are the focal point.

EASA Part-145.A.30 states that personnel functioning as Nominated Persons must demonstrate working knowledge of Part-145 regulations.
