- Review the applicable standards, technical requirements, and operational aspects needed to conduct effective audits

Throughout the course, practical examples and open discussions are used to illustrate the challenges auditors may face, while emphasising auditor behaviour and on-site safety precautions.

COMPLIANCE

Our **Fuelling and De-icing/Anti-icing Audit Training** reflects current regulatory requirements and recognised industry standards for auditing fuelling and de-icing/anti-icing operations.

The training includes relevant guidance from ICAO and EASA, together with recognised industry standards such as JIG 1 for into-plane fuelling and applicable SAE standards for de-icing/anti-icing operations.

Certificates will be issued upon completion of the course.
